

## EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY

Code **JB** Issued **3/13**

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Purpose: To establish the board's vision regarding equal educational opportunities for all students in the district.

The board believes that the district must provide public education in an atmosphere where differences are understood and appreciated. The district should treat all persons fairly, with respect, and without discrimination or threats of violence or abuse.

Every student of this school district will have equal educational opportunities regardless of ethnic or racial background, religious beliefs, sex, disability, economic or social conditions, immigration status or English speaking status. The district schools will advertise this nondiscrimination policy.

This concept of equal educational opportunity serves as a guide for the board and the staff in making decisions related to school facilities, employment of personnel, selection of educational materials, equipment, curriculum and regulations affecting students.
