

## **Artistically Gifted and Talented Programs**

Artistically gifted and talented students are identified through a four-step process:

1. Referral
2. Recommendation
3. Demonstration
4. Placement

In addition to self-referrals, students may be referred by teachers, administrators, parents, or peers. Referral information can be obtained by contacting the school's art or music teachers. The recommendation consists of a checklist completed by a teacher who has observed the student during the school year. Demonstration is accomplished by means of auditions with school and district evaluation teams. Placements are made based on the results of the demonstrations.

Artistically gifted and talented students are served in after school music and art programs. In addition, Woodruff High School 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students have the opportunity to enroll in AP Art.
